## **BUDGET RESOLUTION 2020-188**

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR THE RETROFIT INSTALLATION OF A NUTRIENT REMOVAL FILTRATION SYSTEM WITH BOLD & GOLD MEDIA AT EDGEWOOD PARK POND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$420,000

**WHEREAS**, the City has been awarded a grant through the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) to reduce pollutants in surface water; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant addresses the installation of Nutrient Removing Filtration Systems using Bold and Gold<sup>TM</sup> Media on drainage well at Edgewood Park Pond including expansion of an existing DRA to add 7-acre-ft additional treatment volume, abandon an existing recharge well, and relocate a recharge well to the wet pond including storm drainage piping as needed.

WHEREAS, construction of the replacement wells will help restore and maintain the drainage capacity of Edgewood Park Pond;

WHEREAS, this project is necessary to help Ocala meet the nutrient reduction requirements and to restore drainage capacity at Edgewood Park Pond; and

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection will fund an amount not to exceed \$420,000, and the City will provide a match of \$140,000 which is available in the current year budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session that the FY 2020 budget be amended to accept and appropriate grant funding from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection as outlined below:
