BUDGET RESOLUTION 2019-129

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE SANITATION AND STORMWATER RESERVES FOR CONTINGENCIES TO PAY FOR TWO ENVIRONMENTAL ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND THEIR EQUIPMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$156,390

WHEREAS, as a Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) operator, the City of Ocala is required to establish a construction program that controls all pollutants from running off construction sites; and

WHEREAS, the Phase II Final Rule of the Generic Permit for Discharge of Stormwater from Phase II Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4 GP) requires the development, implementation, and enforcement of a program to reduce pollutants in stormwater runoff; and

WHEREAS, currently the City only has one employee who can devote part of his time to enforcing National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) violations in addition to his other job functions, which is insufficient in complying with the MS4 GP; and

WHEREAS, the two new positions will assist with tracking and enforcing compliance with the Best Management Practices for Minimal Control Measures outlined in the MS4 GP; and

WHEREAS, the positions will also address illegal dumping in the City limits, inspect erosion and sediment control devices on construction sites, and perform field investigations compiling evidence and related information on environmental code or ordinance enforcement cases; and

WHEREAS, the two new positions will be funded by Stormwater and Sanitation and be staffed in Growth Management's Code Enforcement Division.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session, that the FY2019 budget be amended as outlined below to appropriate funding as follows:
