NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled, that the budget, attached hereto, for the Downtown Development Fund budget of $\$ 222,364$ for the period beginning October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020 is hereby tentatively adopted.
