A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT FINAL MILLAGE RATES

FOR ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN DOWNTOWN DISTRICTS

A, B AND C FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020

WHEREAS, Downtown districts A, B and C are independent bodies and are authorized to levy a millage not to exceed five mills for each district; and

WHEREAS, in accordance to Florida Statutes, Section 200.065, the Property Appraiser's Office mailed proposed tax bills on August 15, 2019 and a public hearing scheduled for September 3, 2019 to adopt the tentative millage rates for the Downtown Districts; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was rescheduled for September 17, 2019 due to the anticipated impacts of Hurricane Dorian and was publicly noticed in the Ocala Star Banner on Friday, September 13, 2019 in compliance with the Department of Revenue Office of the Executive Director Emergency Order No. 19-001; and

WHEREAS, the required notice of tax increase and budget advertisements were published on September 20, 2019 and a public hearing to adopt final millage rates and a budget was held on September 24, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, **FLORIDA**, duly assembled, that the tax rate for all taxable property within the Downtown Districts A, B and C are hereby adopted at the following rates:
