## Advertisement of Availability of Coronavirus Funding of \$422,871 Substantial Amendment to the CDBG 2019-2023 Five-Year Consolidated Plan, and Amended 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan

Funding Availability Substantial Amendment 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan Citizen Participation Plan

The City of Ocala Community Development Services is proposing to amend both the 2019-2023 Five Year Consolidated Plan and the 2019 Annual Action Plan for use of awarded Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds.

In accordance with 24 CFR 91.05(c)(2) and subpart B of the federal regulations relative to citizen participation for Community Development Services Programs; and applicable waivers made available to those requirements through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act).

This qualifies as a substantial amendment to the City's 2019-2023 Five Year Consolidated Plan and it's 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan, because the City is allocating newly awarded funding to a previous CDBG program year as instructed by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). This award through the CARES Act will enable the City of Ocala to administer \$422,871 in new funding. Said funding will be allocated to support the following categories that were designed to centralize the City's COVID-19 relief and recovery activities that include:

- Microenterprises
- Educational Programs targeted to students from Low- Moderate Income LMI families who may have fallen behind in their education as a result of the pandemic due to absenteeism, inadequate internet access, or other lack of support for remote learning.
- Public Services
- Broadband infrastructure projects to expand high speed internet access to LMI communities.

The City of Ocala updated the Citizen Participation Plan to provide opportunities for the public to continue to engage in a virtual public comment process, during a shortened regulatory, advertisement, public comment, and virtual hearing timeframe.

Based on the regulatory relief provided in the CARES Act and guidance from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), the public will have five (5) days from publication of this advertisement to provide written comments. ## **Public Comment Period and Process:**

This Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan amendment is available for a 5-day public review and comment period from June 10, 2021 to June 15, 2021.
