## **BUDGET RESOLUTION 2022-113**

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY TO IMPROVE THE DRAINAGE OF A RESIDENTIAL AREA LOCATED AT BOUNDARIES NORTH EAST OF 16TH AVENUE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$230,855

**WHEREAS**, the City has been awarded a grant through the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) DR-4337-376-R, as approved by the Florida Division of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency to improve the drainage of residential area located at boundaries North East of 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue; and

WHEREAS, this grant addresses a drainage improvement project, which includes the construction of a new detention pond to be located at 1613 NE 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue and to elevate 475 linear feet of the adjacent road NE 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Division of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency will fund an amount not to exceed \$230,855, and the City will provide a match of \$74,118 which is available in the current year budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session that the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 budget be amended to accept and appropriate grant funding from the Florida Division of Emergency Management (Division) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) as outlined below:
