BUDGET RESOLUTION 2022-161

A BUDGET RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 BUDGET TO TRANSFER FUNDS FROM THE ELECTRIC RATE STABILIZATION RESERVE AND THE ELECTRIC CONSTRUCTION FUND TO THE ELECTRIC OPERATING FUND RESERVE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,403,102

WHEREAS, the Rate Stabilization Reserve (RSR) is established to provide stabilized rates to customers by reducing rate volatility due to extraordinarily high energy related costs or unanticipated reduction in energy sold; and

WHEREAS, the City's key management practices established Electric Rate Stabilization Reserve (RSR) at a minimum of 15% of projected fuel costs and a maximum of 25%; and

WHEREAS, due to an increase in fuel cost, staff recommends a withdrawal of \$8,000,000 from the rate stabilization reserve to assist in absorbing heightened fuel costs; and

WHEREAS, the withdrawal of funds will preserve a balance of \$12,954,306 placing the rate stabilization reserves below the required policy limits until funds can be recovered and/or fuel prices decrease; and

WHEREAS, as an additional source of funding, staff has identified and postponed to FY23 a capital project in the amount of \$3,403,102 to be transferred to electric reserves; and

WHEREAS, this budget resolution is a necessary administrative function to properly transfer these funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session, that the FY22 budget be amended as outlined below.
