A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE DOWNTOWN DISTRICTS A, B, AND C FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023

WHEREAS, the City of Ocala, Florida, on September 6, 2022, adopted Fiscal Year Tentative Millage Rates for the Downtown Districts A, B, and C following a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ocala, Florida, held a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within the Downtown Districts A, B, and C has been certified by the Marion County Property Appraiser as:

District A: \$36,156,636 District B: \$26,653,566 District C: \$11,709,186

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Ocala, Florida, that:

- 1. The Fiscal Year 2022-2023 operating millage rate for Downtown District A is 1.7185, which is greater than the rolled-back rate of 1.5711 by 9.38%.
- 2. The Fiscal Year 2022-2023 operating millage rate for Downtown District B is 1.6332, which is greater than the rolled-back rate of 1.5044 by 8.56%.
- 3. The Fiscal Year 2022-2023 operating millage rate for Downtown District C is 1.4699, which is greater than the rolled-back rate of 1.4639 by 0.41%.
