BUDGET RESOLUTION 2023-100

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 BUDGET TO ALLOCATE FUNDS FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT TOTALING \$6,101,080

WHEREAS, on January 20, 2020, the Secretary of Health and Human Services declared a public health emergency under section 319 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 247d); and

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization announced that the COVID-19 outbreak can be characterized as a pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, President Joseph R. Biden, Jr. enacted the American Rescue Plan Act; and

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2021, City Council approved a subaward and grant agreement related to the American Rescue Plan Act; and

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2021, the City of Ocala received their first tranche of the American Rescue Plan Act funding which was appropriated on Budget Resolution 2021-163; and

WHEREAS, on August 3, 2021, the City of Ocala Council approved Budget Resolution 2021-163 allocating the first tranche of American Rescue Plan Act funding; and

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2022, the City of Ocala received their second tranche of the American Rescue Plan Act Funding; and

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act revenue will fund City of Ocala lost revenue within the General Fund due to COVID-19 in the amount of \$6,101,080.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session, that the FY2022 budget be amended as outlined below:
