WHEREAS, the city and the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) entered into a Brownfields Assessment Cooperative Agreement on June 21, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Notice of Award was received on August 23, 2022, awarding funding; and

WHEREAS, the City was appropriated funding for FY 2021-2022 through FY 2025-2026 from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to provide environmental assessments on properties either known or suspected of having hazardous substance or petroleum contamination; and

WHEREAS, the environmental assessments assist property owners in redeveloping idle properties to return them to productive use and spur economic development within neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the City was appropriated funds for FY 2022-2023 in the amount of \$500,000 from EPA for the City's Brownfields program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session that the FY 2022-2023 budget be amended as outlined below to appropriate \$500,000 to carry out activities as outlined in the City's EPA-Approved Work Plan.
