

BUDGET RESOLUTION 2023-158

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE RESERVE FOR BUILDING FUND TO PURCHASE PERMITTING SOFTWARE (COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, FORMERLY KNOW AS TRAKiT) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$336,139

WHEREAS, in 2003, the city implemented TRAKiT to streamline permitting/inspections, code enforcement, planning, and licensing processes; and

WHEREAS, eTRAKiT is the city's public-facing portal for online permitting/inspections; and

WHEREAS, in December 2017, the city approved five-year contracts with GovSense and NetSuite to develop new modules that would replace TRAKiT; and

WHEREAS, between 2018-2023, the city transitioned to GovSense hosted on the NetSuite cloud platform for code enforcement, planning, parking, and licensing, but not the permitting module and the public portal; and

WHEREAS, after evaluating the proposed portal and reviewing available options, staff recommends staying with TRAKiT for permitting and migrating the code enforcement, planning, and licensing modules from GovSense back to Community Development.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session,




