A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM MARION COUNTY FOR THE CHALLENGE GRANT FOR THE MARION COUNTY CONTINUUM OF CARE (COC) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$52,000

WHEREAS, the City of Ocala, as part of the Marion County Joint Office on Homelessness, provides outreach and referral services to homeless individuals and families throughout Marion County; and

WHEREAS, the City is also the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) lead agency for the Marion County Continuum of Care (CoC) and provides Coordinated Entry for the community organizations that provide homeless services in the County; and

WHEREAS, the Marion County CoC has awarded the City of Ocala \$52,000 in grant funding from its annual allocation. The award is to be used for expenses related to providing referral and coordinated entry services. Staff recommends approval.
