

BUDGET RESOLUTION 2021-129

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FY21 GENERAL FUND RESERVE FOR CONTINGENCY BUDGET FOR PINE OAKS ENVIRONMENTAL CONSULTING SERVICES INCLUDING ADDITIONAL WATER AND SOIL SAMPLING, GROUNDWATER MONITORING, AND A REVISED REMEDIAL ACTION PLAN IN THE AMOUNT OF \$133,700

WHEREAS, the City as the property owner for the Pine Oaks Golf Course must conduct additional water sampling, soil sampling, and groundwater monitoring at the golf course site. The City is also required to submit a revised remedial action plan (RAP) to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) prior to any development of said property; and

WHEREAS, the current budget is not adequate to fund the project and additional funding is necessary to complete the project; and,

WHEREAS, the future housing development project is an important improvement that will benefit the City of Ocala residents; and

WHEREAS, this project is an appropriate use of the General Fund Reserve for Contingencies and the balance is sufficient to pay for this additional water and soil sampling, groundwater monitoring, and revised remedial action plan.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session, that the FY2021 Budget be amended as outlined below to appropriate funding as follows:


