RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND UNIVERSITY OF NORTH FLORIDA, INSTITUTE OF POLICE TECHNOLOGY AND MANAGEMENT TOTALING \$18,200

WHEREAS, The Ocala Police Department recognizes that the community has suffered recently from unnecessary injuries and fatalities related to pedestrians and bicyclists using or crossing Ocala's many roadways; and

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2019, the Ocala Police Department was invited to participate in an agreement with the University of North Florida, sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation, through May 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the University of North Florida Institute of Police Technology and Management has awarded \$18,200 for reimbursement of overtime expenses incurred by sworn officers conducting high visibility enforcement and education.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session, that the FY2018-2019 budget be amended as outlined below to appropriate \$18,200 for overtime expenses incurred during high visibility grant activities.
