BUDGET RESOLUTION 2020-124

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR LIGHTING OF THE OCALA SKATEPARK AND DESIGN OF A RESTROOM/VENDING BUILDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$88,000

WHEREAS, The City of Ocala has a skatepark at Tuscawilla Park that is highly utilized and which has no lighting or restrooms; and

WHEREAS, During the winter months (standard time), the park must be closed at 5:30 p.m. due to shorter days and earlier sunsets. This is problematic for school-aged youth and working adults who can not use the park except on weekends; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ocala is committed to providing quality places for the community and investing in the continued development of the skatepark; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ocala will fund lighting at the skatepark in the amount of \$115,000 and the design of a future restroom/vending building in the amount of \$5,000; and

WHEREAS, the Electric Construction Fund has adequate funding budgeted for their portion of the project (\$32,000), and the General Fund Reserve for Contingencies has adequate funding to cover the balance of the project cost (\$88,000).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCALA, FLORIDA, duly assembled in regular session that the City of Ocala FY2020 budget be amended to appropriate \$88,000 for lighting of the skatepark and design of a restroom/vending building as outlined below.
